County Facilities Millage Proposal

Shall the limitation upon the total amount of general ad valorem taxes imposed upon real and tangible personal property for all purposes in any one year under the Michigan Constitution be increased in the County of Kalkaska by a new additional millage of 1.50 mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of 20 years, 2019 through 2038, to provide funding for the operation and maintenance of the Kaliseum Recreation Complex, including, without limitation, the costs of acquiring, constructing, expanding, equipping, and/or improving the building, its facilities, pools, roofing systems, and the site therefor, including funding reserves to maintain such complex in good repair and working order, to provide funding for lighting improvements for energy conservation purposes at County facilities, and to provide funding for payment of debt service on obligations issued for such purposes? The revenue collected in the first year from the levy is estimated to be \$1,196,086. In addition to the County of Kalkaska, a portion of the revenue from this millage may be disbursed to the Village of Kalkaska Downtown Development Authority, in accordance with State law.
