**Kalkaska County Commission on Aging  
Millage Renewal and Restoration Proposal**

For the purpose of providing funds for the continued operation, expenses, and capital improvements of the Kalkaska County Commission on Aging at the same millage level approved by the voters in 2016, shall the Constitutional limitation upon the total amount of taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of Kalkaska, Michigan, be renewed at 0.4996 of one (1) mill, and shall the previously authorized reduced millage of 0.0004 of one (1) mill be restored, for a return to the previously voted total limitation increase of 0.5 of one (1) mill, and shall the County be authorized to levy, up to 0.5 mill (\$0.50 per \$1,000 of Taxable Value) for a period of six (6) years, 2022 through 2027, inclusive?

If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated \$438,017 for providing funds for operations, expenses, and capital improvements for the Kalkaska County Commission on Aging in the first calendar year of the levy based on taxable value. In accordance with State law, a portion of the millage may be disbursed to the Downtown Development Authority of the Village of Kalkaska.
